- **Walk the Bob & Cresta** – a bespoke walking map of the world famous Cresta run and Olympic Bob Sleigh is available for guests to enjoy a gentle walk along these sporting paths, normally fueled by speed and adrenaline during the winter months, slowed down a few gears for summer
- **Alpine Play – Classic Lawn Games** - from Badminton to croquet; there is a treasure chest full of games for guests to compete in on the Kulm Country Club Great Lawn.
- **Fireside Feasting - An Alpine Asado** – a weekly Argentinian BBQ, curated by Michelin Starred chef, Mauro Colagreco, bringing his signature Asado to the heart of St. Moritz with premium cuts grilled over smouldering embers, vibrant seasonal sides, and the unmistakable warmth of a meal shared in true Argentinian style.
- **Scenic Picnics & Lake Retreats** – with picnic spots throughout the Kulm Park, guests can enjoy a leisurely lunch with a luxury hamper prepared by the kitchen team, full of fresh regional produce, gourmet cheeses, and Swiss delicacies. Or, take to the lake for some paddleboarding and wild swimming in the glacial waters.
- **Hiking & Trail Exploration** – for those who wish to explore further afield, the Engadin valley boasts miles of hiking trails from gentle meadow walks to summit climbs.

- **Cycling & E-Bike Adventures** – or take two wheels, with options for tackling mountain bike trails or enjoying a leisurely e-bike ride through the valleys.

In addition to the regular activities, there is a calendar of exciting events happening at the Kulm Hotel and within St. Moritz during the summer season.
